# **Gathering**

6:15

Congregants are welcomed at the door by the greeter.

The **greeter** brings them inside, gets them a name tag, and hooks them into preparations for the meal.

7:00

The **deacon** checks to be sure the tables are fully set, with bread all set out on the same table.

The **deacon** checks in with the lead cook, Coordinator, and the presider, then rings the bell and says:

-Come and gather around the candle!

The **shruti box** begins, The **deacon** hands out candles, The **song leader** beings a drone.

#### **Introductions**

### The **Presider** says:

- -Welcome.
- -St. Lydia's is a church where we share a sacred meal just as the first followers of Jesus did.
- -Introduce self, Coordinator, Song Leader, and Deacon.
- -"The Deacon will lead you through the service as we go."

## The **Deacon** says:

- -We'll process to the tables now, singing a song that \_\_\_\_\_ will teach.
- -When you get there, light all the candles on the tables and then plant your candle in the trays of rice.
- -Then, we'll stand in one large circle around all the tables.

# **Candle Lighting**

The **Song Leader** leads:

The Lord is My Light

a cappella

The **Deacon** passes the light to one person. Everyone moves to the tables.

Once everyone is gathered and all candles are lit, the **Song Leader** signals end of song.

- -We pray with hands lifted, as was the custom in the early church.
- -After you receive the bread, give your neighbor a piece, saying, "This is my body."

The **Song Leader** ends the time of prayer by repeating the song.
