Psalm 27 is a confident profession of faith and declaration of trust in God. The psalmist is profoundly aware of the enemy's threats but is even more aware of God's ultimate protection and the beauty of ongoing communion with God. The psalm deftly interweaves two contrasting sets of images: one focusing on perception (God as light, beholding God's beauty, seeing God's goodness) and the other on deliverance (God as salvation and shelter). Use in Worship: *funerary; pastoral care of the sick and distressed.*
